Electoral cycle regimes and election dates

For Switzerland we were not able to find the exact dates for all types of referenda in all of the cantons. Given the frequent use of the referendum instrument at the federal, cantonal and municipal level we estimate that there has been a referendum held within one year before and after each cantonal election. The results are robust when we exclude referenda.

Local and sub-regional election dates

Apart from local (municipal) elections there are provincial elections in Belgium, Italy, and Spain and elections for the *department* in France and *Kreise* or *Bezirke* in Germany. Below we detail our sources (literature, legislation, and websites) with regard to local and other sub-regional election dates. It appeared to be difficult to find local election dates for those regions which have the authority to set a local date of their own choosing (often the case in federal and regionalized countries). However, we were able to determine the length of the local election cycle and the kind of local election regime, that is, whether local government choose their own election dates or whether local elections are held horizontally simultaneous within the region. In addition, we were able to find dates for the more recent elections which allowed us to estimate the dates for earlier local elections based on election cycles determined in legislation (e.g. every fourth year on the fourth Monday in October) or via elections dates for particular municipalities. To increase validity of this indicator we prefer to use a dummy variable for a voter fatigue and referendum voting effect rather than the exact number of days between local and regional elections. We ran our models which excluded the imputed local election dates and the results remain robust.
